Grant the removal of current restrictions – these are already adequately controlled within the Licensing Objectives.

Grant permission to sell alcohol from 10 am – there are no objections to this starting time.

Grant permission to sell alcohol until 1am instead of the 2am applied for. This was offered previously by Mr Hogg at the informal meeting held in an attempt to resolve this situation.

RE: APPLICATION TO VARY LICENCE CONDITIONS - FANTAILS

Further to our telephone conversation on 26 June 2007 regarding your application to vary your current licence conditions, I wish to confirm my observations.

This department has not received any complaint of noise nuisances concerned with Fantails since summer 2004. Before that, isolated complaints had been received in January 2003 and December 2002.

As we discussed, I wish to stress the importance of effective control of potential noise sources at Fantails. These include:

- Strict compliance with the undertakings given in Part 4 P(d) of your application form.
- 2. Careful regulation of sound levels emanating from entertainment media e.g. amplified music, speech and televisions within the Fantails site area, i.e. premises, yard/garden and forecourt.
- 3. Supervision and control of persons congregating externally, particularly as a consequence of smoke free premises legislation. You explained that the premises have been completely non-smoking for a few years with customers resorting to the garden or forecourt areas to smoke.

During our telephone conversation, you confirmed that you do not envisage any substantial change to the nature of the business operations at Fantails.



Consequently, you did not believe that the "noise characteristics" of the premises would deteriorate. Obviously, you must give prior consideration to the potential noise impact of any new activities and ensure appropriate noise controls are in place.

I trust this is acceptable to you, and confirms your verbal agreement during our telephone conversation. Please do not hesitate to contact me should you wish to discuss this matter further.
