LC.19/13 MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

LC.20/13 UPDATE ON LICENSING ACT 2003

The Licensing Manager presented report GD.46/13 giving Members an update on the applications under the Licensing Act 2003.

The Licensing Manager reported on the licence figures as 4 October 2013. He reported that all fees under the Licensing Act were fixed by Central Government and would be reviewed to ensure that Licensing Authorities recovered the full cost of administrating the licensing function.

He added that the Government had indicated that they were looking at further deregulation of regulated entertainment and the future of the personal licence system for alcohol licensing. The Licensing Manager would respond to any consultation on the subject.

The Licensing Manager reported that the Carlisle and Eden Best Bar None Scheme 2013 was in the final month of the assessment programme and 23 applications had been received.
