| The Director of Community Services submitted Report CS.09/06 updating the Executive on key issues for the practical implementation of the Act. Details of the new powers available to Local Authorities under the provisions of the Act were submitted. A one-off allocation of funding for implementation of the Act and environmental improvements had been included in the 2006/07 Budget. The report outlined the way in which it was intended to deal with the new powers and which included - - preparing an awareness/education strategy in conjunction with the Communications Team; - looking at a range of enforcement issues; - adopting a partnership approach with the Police, Housing Associations and the County Council through its Waste and Trading Standards functions; - looking at making a range of significant changes in the delivery and improvement of existing services. The Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act had been a joint Overview and Scrutiny subject review and the Community and Infrastructure Overview and Scrutiny Committees could be invited to comment on the implementation proposals. A workshop for the Infrastructure Overview and Scrutiny Committee has been arranged for 10 April 2006. Members commented that progress in this area was very important for the people of Carlisle.
