#### 1. Notice of Key Executive Decisions

Notice of Key Executive Decisions were published on 15<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> December 2014 and were circulated to all Members. The following items were included in the notices and fall into the remit of this Panel:

- KD25/14 **Budget Process 2015/16** considered at the meeting of the Panel on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2014.
- KD.30/14 Carlisle Plan the draft Carlisle Plan was due to be initially considered by the Executive on 14<sup>th</sup> January prior to referral to scrutiny. This item has now been deferred and the revised timetable for approval is still to be confirmed.
- KD.31/14 Carlisle District Local Plan (2015-2030) Proposed Submission on the agenda of this Panel meeting
- KD.02/15 **Green Box Collection Service** a private report will be considered by the Executive at its meeting on 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2015 to ask to award a contract for the green box service.

#### 3. Task and Finish Groups

#### Litter Bin

The interim report from the Task Group was presented to the last meeting of the Panel on 27<sup>th</sup> November. The Group met with Local Environment Officers on 11<sup>th</sup> December and as Officers were collating further evidence on the audit of bins the group would wait until this was undertaken and circulated and would meet again in February 2015.

#### **Business Support**

The Task Group held its initial meeting on 9<sup>th</sup> December 2014 to scope the review and to agree the Terms of Reference. These are attached at Appendix 1 and the Panel are requested to give approval to the remits of the work. The Task Group are due to visit the Growth Hub on 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2015.

#### 4. Environmental Performance of the Council

The Panel agreed its work programme at the beginning of the Civic Year and agreed that the annual report on the Environment Performance of the Council be brought inline with the annual Performance Reports and receive 2014/15 figures in June 2015 rather than continuing with receiving past years figures the following January. The Panel agreed that figures for 2013/14 be submitted to this meeting of the Panel for information only to be assured that performance continued on target. The figures are attached to this report at Appendix 2.

#### 5. Facilitated Session for Scrutiny Members

The LGA Future Council Review which took place in September 2014 suggested that it was timely to review the Council's scrutiny arrangements to make better use of members' skills and interests and provide a greater focus on council priorities.

The Scrutiny Chairs Group considered how this should be addressed at their meeting on 4<sup>th</sup> November 2014 and agreed that a facilitated discussion be arranged for scrutiny members of the Council. The

Centre for Public Scrutiny (CfPS) have been appointed to facilitate and the session will cover the following:

- The role and function of scrutiny. This will look at the potential for scrutiny to effect meaningful change, scrutiny's powers and responsibilities, and how it can contribute to ensuring that decisionmaking occurs with speed and pace, without sacrificing on effective reflection and challenge as an integral part of the decision-making process. It will look at the respective role of scrutiny and policy commissions, and the impact of party politics on scrutiny.
- The resources to carry out this role. This will look at members' capacity and capability, and members' skills, and the skills and capacity of the officers supporting them throughout the council.
- The structures to support the role within the resources available. What is the best approach?

This will be held at the Civic Centre on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2015, 1:30pm - 4:00pm. More information will be sent to Members and it is requested that in the meantime you pencil this date in your diary.
