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GENERAL FUND CAPITAL PROGRAMME 2001/02 AND 2002/03

BACKGROUND INFORMATION AND OPTIONS

- 1.1 This report sets out the summarised provisional financial out-turn for the General Fund Capital Programme as follows:
 - Appendix 1 Details the out-turn for individual schemes
 - Appendix 2 Details the revised programme for 2002/03
- 1.2 Please note that throughout this report a minus (-) figure represents a favourable variance i.e. either an underspend or additional income received.

SUMMARY FINANCIAL OUTTURN 2001/02

2.1 Appendix 1 details the out-turn for schemes included within the General Fund Capital Programme compared to the revised budget approved by the Council in February 2002. The totals provided in Appendix 1 are summarised in the table below:

2.2 This report sets out below the financial implications arising from the out-turn including the impact on the capital resource implications for 2002/03.

EXPLANATION OF MAJOR VARIANCES

- 3.1 During the year, as well the deferment of purchases totalling £391,330 which will be funded in 2002/03, 24 items of vehicles, plant and equipment amounting to £212,652 were financed via an operational lease as opposed to being funded from the Repairs and Renewals Reserve. This has resulted in a reduced call on the Repairs and Renewals Reserve in 2001/02 of £597,932 which includes a net overspend of £6,050.
- 3.2 The Millennium Gateway Scheme underspend of £950,451 can be mainly attributed to the delay in the submission of final elements in respect of the many works packages awarded in respect of the project. This sum is required to be carried forward as slippage into 2002/03 in order to complete the scheme.
- 3.3 Improvement work at the Cemetery is continuing and the budget of £94,550 is required so that the scheme can be finalised.

- 3. Usable capital receipts generated during 2001/02 to support the General Fund (GF) Capital Programme amount to £1,101,900 compared to the revised estimate of £150,940, an increase of £950,960. £325,000 of HIP capital receipts were also allocated to support the City Gateway Scheme as approved by Council in February 2002 and these receipts have been fully utilised. The increased call on GF capital receipts in 2001/02 to fund the programme (£1,556) results in a balance of capital receipts of £949,404 being carried forward to support the capital programme in 2002/03. However £490,940 has been earmarked to fund the programme in 2002/03 and with the anticipated receipts to be generated estimated at £100,000 in 2002/03 this leaves £558,464 of uncommitted funding.

CAPITAL PROGRAMME 2002/03

5.1 The revised Capital Programme for 2002/03 totalling £2,789,881 is detailed in Appendix 2 along with the revised budgets for those other schemes funded from Capital Resources. This is based upon the programme as agreed by Council in February 2002 together with the commitments brought forward from the previous financial year as also identified. These, together with the relevant proposed methods of financing, will ultimately require approval by full Council.
