PROVISIONAL OUTTURN POSITION 2002/03

FOR COUNCIL TAX AND NATIONAL NON-DOMESTIC RATES

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The aim of this report is to:

- i. Advise Members of the current position on the 2002/03 Council Tax and Business Rates Accounts i.e. the total value of accounts raised and how much has been collected in the 2002/03 financial year.
- ii. Highlight and explain any variances against the expected (or budgeted) position. Also other factors that might be of interest to Members representing Carlisle Council Tax payers.

1. COUNCIL TAX PROVISIONAL OUTTURN AS AT 31 MARCH 2003

- 1. At Appendix 1 is detailed the provisional outturn position for Council Tax for 2002/03 and the outstanding arrears 1993/94 to 2001/02.
 - 2.2 The estimated outturn suggests potentially better than expected collection rates. The Council budgeted for a 2.0% loss on collection and liability (£698,765) for 2002/03 whereas if the collection pattern for recovering 2002/03 arrears follows that of previous years (based on 1993/94 position), losses on collection will be restricted to approximately 1% (£349,382). A 99% collection rate of net Council Tax liability raised is on a par with the collection levels experienced by the Council under the old General rates system.
- 3. Year-end arrears of £1,148,886 for 2002/03 equating to 3.4% of debit collectable shows a steady year on year improvement on the position as at 2001/02 (3.6%) despite the continuing impact of the Benefit Verification Framework on Council Tax administration.
- 4. Overall, the provisional outturn suggests a very successful year in administering Council Tax especially when it is considered that very considerable key staff resources had to be targeted at restructuring the Unit i.e. better focusing resources on Service delivery and Customer Contact.

2. NNDR PROVISIONAL OUTTURN AS AT 31 MARCH 2003

- 1. At Appendix 2 is detailed the NNDR provisional outturn for 2002/03.
- 2. Year-end arrears at £554,211 equating to 2.3% continues the marked year on year improvement when compared with the figures for 1999/2000 i.e. £934,959 (4.7%), 2000/01 i.e. £900,066 (3.8%) and 2001/02 i.e. £796.112 (2.9%). However over the next few years arrears levels could fluctuate as the City expands. Industrial estates such as Kingmoor Park have yet to be fully developed and rated. If the Valuation Officer advises the Council of such

Rating Assessments late in the financial year it is often too late to get the resulting rates liability paid (often amounting to £100,000 plus per hereditament) resulting in significant additional year end arrears.

3. COMMUNITY CHARGE ACCOUNTS

 Although Community Charge Accounts have been closed down, outstanding liability is still being recovered and £1,216 was recovered in 2002/03 and will be available for distribution to Council Tax Payers as part of the surplus distribution.
