Resolution / Question:

The scheme offered by TerraCycle UK in partnership with Walkers – the response to include details of how many packets of crisps there are in a kilo; the financial reward for every kilo of crisp packets recycled; the Community Centres and other public sites across Carlisle district which were involved.

Response:

The Terracycle UK crisp recycling scheme is free to use and is supported by Walkers Crisps.

- Freepost parcel labels are printed off and called in for collection
- The scheme offers points for every 2kg collected
- 2kg = £4
- Approx 600 packets in 2kg

At present we have collection bins at:

- 1. Currock Community Centre
- 2. Denton Holme Community Centre
- 3. Harraby Community Centre
- 4. Longtown Community Centre
- 5. Impact Furniture Services, Nelson Street
- 6. Civic Centre

We are investigating other suitable sites throughout the District. Host sites are provided with clear recycled liners and contact us when they have a few bags for collection. Our Street Cleaning Team collect the bags whilst they are on their rounds, thus reducing unnecessary travel miles.

Whist this isn't going to raise huge amounts, it supports a local charity, raises awareness and recycles a product that would otherwise have been thrown away.
