Places: creating attractive and vibrant places to live, work and visit across the whole Borderlands region.




Ideas: nurturing a vibrant SME community to innovate and scale up, building on existing strengths and emerging capabilities.

Skills: improving access to training and education for residents and businesses to help increase productivity




Carlisle Focus


Carlisle Station Gateway

Objectives:

- 1. Improving connectivity to and from the Borderlands area
- 2. Increasing the vibrancy of the Carlisle City Centre


Elements:

- 1. Improvement of Carlisle station
- 2. Re-development of the Citadels and adjacent land / buildings
- 3. Development of Caldew Riverside



Carlisle Station Gateway

Key Sites



Carlisle Station / The Pools

Master planning exercise jointly funded by Cumbria County Council, Carlisle City Council and Cumbria LEP.

Objectives:

- Improved commercial & interchange facilities
- Better access and increased car parking provision
- Enhanced public realm

Outcomes:

- Improved and more accessible station
- An attractive destination and arrival point
- Securing high-speed connectivity for Carlisle / Borderlands



Citadels / Caldew Riverside

City Council working with private sector to explore the potential for mixed-use development across these sites.

Objectives:

- Creation of new high-quality commercial, leisure and retail floor space
- Improved public realm
- Improved connectivity between station, city centre and riverside areas

Outcomes:

- Improved city centre offer / 'experience'
- More vibrant city centre night time economy
- Increase demand for city centre living



Next Steps

- Co-development and discussion with Government officials
- Refinement of strategic outline business cases (SOBC's) in response to feedback
- Prepare final SOBCs and Deal Document
- Seek necessary approvals from the Borderlands local authority partners
- Submit final SOBCs and Deal document end September
