To consider applications received for grant assistance from the Grants for Leisure Budget 2007/08. The decisions are taken in accordance with Paragraph 8.1 of the Leader's Scheme of Delegation.

Summary of Options rejected

DECISION

(1) That the application from Lakeland Opera towards the cost of a production in November 2007 at the Sands Centre and workshops at Trinity and St Aidans Schools, be refused on the grounds that they have already received a grant from the Neighbourhood Forum.

(2) That Cumbria Institute of the Arts be awarded a grant of £400 towards the cost of an exhibition, by 3rd year fine art students, which will be open to the public free of charge for 2 weeks.

(3) That Stagedright Youth Theatre be awarded a grant of £700 towards the cost of staging a production of Les Miserables at the Sands Centre and educational workshops.

(4) That the application from Border City Wheelers towards the cost of providing British Cycling Go-Ride sessions at Carlisle Airport and schools in the Carlisle area, be refused on the grounds that they have already received a grant from the Neighbourhood Forum.

(5) That Carlisle Masters be awarded a grant of £500 towards the cost of holding a swim meet in May 2007, attracting swimmers from all over the UK and Eire.

(6) That Vitalise be awarded a grant of £400 towards the cost of subsidising planned breaks for disabled people who are local people, enabling their carers to have a rest.

(7) That Petteril Bank Community Centre, as funding agent, be awarded a grant of £500 towards the cost of a city wide project with 5 community centres taking part in organising a fun sports day for 8 to 12 year olds. The day will be held in August 2007 at Belah and Harraby Community Centres and will promote positive integration, healthy living and good citizenship.

(8) The Asian Womens Group (Carlisle) be awarded £500 towards the cost of a one day multi cultural event to be held on 19 June at Greystone Community Centre.
