1. Development Session

Members attended a development session on 22nd July 2010 to look at the Panel's Work Programme for this Civic Year. Notes of the session are attached at Appendix 1 for information. The work programme has been amended to reflect the decisions made at the Development Session and Members are asked to approve the amended Work Programme which is attached at Appendix 2.

2. Forward Plan Items

The Forward Plan of the Executive covering the period 1 September to 31st December 2010 was published on 18th August 2010. The issues which fall within the remit of this Panel are as follows. Full details can be found at Appendix 3.

KD027/10 Third Local Transport Plan (2011-2026) – the Panel will consider this item at this meeting of the Panel

KD025/10 Shoreline Management Plan 2 Adoption – the Panel are requested to consider whether they wish to consider this item at the next meeting of the Panel on 21st October 2010.

3. Strategic Waste Partnership

Members are to consider a 6 monthly update on Waste Services at this meeting. However, Members may recall that they made a referral to the Cumbria Joint Scrutiny Committee in April 2010 regarding the Strategic Waste Partnership.

That the Panel was concerned about the slow progress being made by the Cumbria Strategic Waste Partnership with some of its objectives. With this in mind, the Cumbria Scrutiny Panel should be asked to carry out a piece of Task and Finish Group work, examining ways forward for the Cumbria Strategic Waste Partnership.

The Joint Committee considered the referral at their meeting on 29th April and decided that, as there was an 'options project' due to end in June 2010, they would await the outcomes of that work before determining whether to pursue the referral as a scrutiny topic.

The Waste Services Manager attended the next meeting of the Joint Committee in July 2010 to present an update on findings from the options project. The Committee were informed that there is currently no dedicated Waste Partnership Officer and determined that they would support the reinstatement of this post. They further agreed that they would not undertake a piece of Task and Finish work on this topic but would keep a monitoring eye on the strategy.

4. Area Working Task and Finish Group

The initial meeting of the Task Group is to be held on 7th September 2010. If available, the agreed Terms of Reference for the Task Group will be tabled at today's meeting for formal approval by Members of the Panel.

5. Core Strategy

It has been agreed with the Chair of the Panel and the Strategic Director that the workshop on the Core Strategy will be arranged for the end of September.

Members were informed that the purpose of the session was to:

In the Civic Year 2009/10 the Panel held 9 meetings, including 1 special meeting and spent 24 hours in formal meetings considering a total of 36 substantive agenda items. Cllr Watson stated that these stats were not outcome based and the Panel should be monitoring outcomes. It was agreed that the Scrutiny Officer would develop a system to monitor outcomes for the next year.

Cllr Hendry suggested that the Panel look at the economic impact Tullie House has on the Carlisle Economy and it was agreed that a report be requested for the Panel on 21st October 2010. Cllr Hendry would liaise with the relevant officer(s) in the development of this report.

Cllr Bainbridge suggested that the Panel look at the issue of seagulls in the city centre. It was agreed that Cllr Bainbridge and the Scrutiny Officer undertake some preliminary research and bring this back to the Panel in September.

The issue of Lead Members was discussed and it was agreed that rather than allocate Members to topics at this time appointments would be made on an ad-hoc basis.

Session with Portfolio Members and Officers

Councillor Mrs Bowman and Chris Hardman, Assistant Director (Economic Development) attended the session.

The objective of this session was to inform Members of priorities, ongoing work and future developments of Policy over the next 12 months. Scrutiny Members would then be able to plan their work programme accordingly and may also identify areas of pre-policy work.

The following were discussed and agreed:

Core Strategy – a workshop to be held in the Autumn City Centre Partnership – report to October meeting Future Land Allocations – report to September meeting

It was also agreed that a training session re: planning which is to be held in August would be extended to Members of E&E Panel.

Panel's Work Programme and Topics for Review

A Task and Finish Group would be appointed to undertake a review of Area Working – initial volunteers to the group were Cllrs Rutherford, Robson & Vasey and invitation to joint the group would be extended to other Members (except Executive Members).

Cllr Bainbridge would undertake some work on control of seagulls.

It was agreed that Cllrs Rutherford and Vasey would attend the meeting of ROSP on 29th July 2010 where the Medium Term Financial Plan was to be discussed.
