***Opening of Eagles Have Landed Exhibition***

On the 28<sup>th</sup> January the opening of the touring exhibition "The Eagles Have Landed" took place. This exhibition, the trailblazer to the Roman Frontier Exhibition commissioned, researched and toured by staff at Tullie House has been exhibited at Segudunum at South Shields and then Senhouse Museum at Maryport. There have been requests to tour the exhibition to other venues after the showing at Tullie House and this is being investigated.

There has been considerable media interest in the exhibition including a full page spread in the News and Star. The Daily Telegraph featured an article on Hadrian's Wall and gave a good account of "The Eagles Have Landed" and the Roman Frontier Gallery.

***Pre-Raphaelites and their Heirs***

On 7 January Lord Henley opened the “Pre-Raphaelites and their Heirs” in Old Tullie House. The new galleries including the Panelled Room have been refurbished with the support of funding from the Department of Culture Media and Sport/ Wolfson Galleries Improvement Funds, Carlisle City Council and the Friends of Tullie House.
