OSM.19/02 LISTENING TO THE RURAL VOICE – A STRATEGY FOR RURAL CARLISLE

The Economic Development Manager attended the meeting and presented report EDU.02/02 containing the "Listening to the Rural Voice" – A Strategy for Rural Carlisle. He advised that the strategy was in response to the Rural White Paper and the findings of the Rural Voice Consultations held in 1999/00. It was written as a Delivery Plan within City Vision and showed how the aspirations in City Vision could be taken forward in rural Carlisle.

The Economic Development Manager referred to the sections of the Strategy on developing the vision for communities in rural Carlisle in paragraph 6 of the report, and asked that Overview and Scrutiny Committees provide responses to the bullet points in that section.

Members commented on the need for action in relation to the Strategy and discussed the mechanism for consideration of the Strategy by the Overview and Scrutiny Committees.

Members recognised that under the current Constitution, the Management Committee could not give consideration to the Strategy but commented that due to its significant corporate implications, each of the Overview and Scrutiny Committees should be asked for comments.

RESOLVED – (1) That the "Listening to the Rural Voice" – A Strategy for Rural Carlisle be referred to each of the Overview and Scrutiny Committees for comments in relation to each of their specific areas. The comments of each Committee would thereafter be consolidated by Officers and submitted to the Chairman of the Corporate Resources Overview and Scrutiny Committee for final approval and submission to the Executive.

(2) That when the comments are forwarded to the Executive, the Chairman of the Corporate Resources Overview and Scrutiny Committee attend that Executive meeting to outline the comments.
