Subject Matter:	<p>Following a sustained period of anti-social behaviour complaints concerning usage of Carlisle City Council owned and managed car parks (West Walls, Caldew Riverside and Castle) the Portfolio Holder has now considered a range of options that may control usage of these assets and decided to install gates that allow these car parks to be closed at night.</p> <p>The Council's officers and Portfolio Holder have considered the anti-social behaviour complaints raised by residents, consulted with the Police, ward Councillors and listened to the concerns raised by other Councillors, city centre establishments and night time users.</p>
