Notice of Intention to Conduct Urgent Business in Private

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 5 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that the following urgent item is likely to be considered in private:

A private report of the Deputy Chief Executive concerning Tullie House - Phase 2 (Arts Council, England, Town Deal and Future High Streets Funded Project). Insert details. The Council were unaware of the conditions set by the Arts Council which have required the matter to be accelerated in order to draw down the funding. The decision is therefore urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.

The reason that the item is likely to be considered in private is that it will involve the disclosure of exempt information under the following categories of Part 1 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972:

Paragraph 5 – Exempt information in respect of which a claim to legal professional privilege could be maintained in legal proceedings
