Subject Matter:

A Notice has been issued under Section 215 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 as to land adversely affecting the amenity of the area, namely a property known as 95 Burgh Road, Carlisle, CA2 7NB.

The Council has served a Section 215 Notice on the occupier to remove a variety of materials from the gardens following complaints from neighbouring residents.

Summary of Options rejected:

Assistance has been offered to the occupier by means of permits to enable the occupier to dispose of the materials at the civic amentiy site. A skip has also been provided but no action has been taken by the occupier to fill the skip.

DECISION:

To implement the steps specified in the schedule to the Section 215 Notice in order to remedy the condition of the land.

Reasons for Decision:

The Section 215 Notice has not been complied with and a decision has been taken to carry out direct action to remove the materials from the land.
