DECISION

- (1) That it be a recommendation to the City Council meeting on 5 February 2002 that the proposed programme of improvement works to be carried out under the 2002/03 Integrated Public Sector Improvement Programme be approved and that:-
 - (a) the total combined budget resource of £4,432,000 in 2002/03 be divided and allocated to each initiative as shown in Section 2 of Report H.117/01 but notes that £300,000 of this budget would be held as a contingency and be subject to release on the specific approval of the City Council;
 - (b) a budget allocation of £35,000 be separately identified for work to be carried out under the Government's New Deal Initiative.
- (2) That it is noted that the 2002/03 Integrated Public Sector Improvement Programme has been discussed with the Carlisle and Rural Tenants Federation and that the detail would now be agreed with Tenants' Groups and Ward Councillors.
- (3) That it be a recommendation to the City Council meeting on 5 February 2002 that £320,000 be transferred from the Planned Maintenance Budget Resource on the 2001/02 Housing Revenue Account to address an overspend in the voids budget.
