
- 1) The premises occupied by The Griffin public house is situated at Court Square, Carlisle. This is in the centre of the city and is primarily a business area, but also part residential with hotel premises next door (Appendix A). The premises have the benefit of a Public Entertainment Licence with operating hours as at paragraph 4 below. The licensee now makes application for a variation to the Public Entertainment Licence hours in respect of the premises (Appendix B)
- Richard Arnott of Dickinson Lees Law Firm, Newcastle upon Tyne, represents the applicant.
- 3) Licensee: Dionne Dillon, The Griffin, Court Square, Carlisle
- 4) The current Public Entertainment operating hours are as follows:
 - · Monday to Saturday (inclusive) 11am until midnight
 - Sundays 12 noon until midnight
- 5) The variation to the hours of operation requested are:
 - Monday to Saturday (inclusive) 11am until 1am the following day
 - Sundays 12 noon until 12.30am the following day and 1am on a Sunday that immediately precedes a Bank Holiday (except Easter Sunday)
- 6) Schedule1 to the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 is the legislation for the licensing of public entertainment. Section 16 of the Schedule reads as follows:
 - (1) The holder of an entertainment licence may at any time apply to the appropriate authority for such variations of the terms, conditions or restrictions on or subject to which the licence is held as may be specified in the application.
 - (2) An authority to whom an application under sub-paragraph (1) above is made may:
 - (a) Make the variations specified in the application.
 - (b) Make such variations as they think fit including the imposition of terms, conditions or restrictions other than those so specified; or
 - (c) Refuse the application.
- 7) Comments are awaited from Planning Services
- 8) Comments are awaited from Cumbria Fire Service
- Environmental Services have no objections to the application. They comment that
 patrons leaving such an establishment can cause disturbance, however this is usually
 outside the scope of normal abatement legislation (Appendix C)

- 10) Cumbria Constabulary have no objections (Appendix D)
- 11) This application has been advertised in the local paper and at this date no objections have been received. The closing date for objections is 2nd May 2003.

OPTIONS

- 1. To refuse the application
- To grant a variation to the Public Entertainment in respect of the hours requested or to such hours as the Panel consider appropriate subject to:
 - a) the Council's Licensing Officer being satisfied that any requirements of Cumbria Fire Service and Planning Services are fully met and inspected and confirmed to that effect
 - b) there being no objections lodged by the closing date of 2nd May 2003


