Following the request from the Corporate Resources Scrutiny Committee, real progress is now being made in identifying viable means for the 'Leadership role of Councillors' in their own wards to be improved. The Corporate Resources Scrutiny & Overview Committee strongly felt that this should be primarily through a series of ward based 'consultative bodies', similar in the way that 'Neighbourhood forums' operate at the moment on Cumbria County Council.

- Increase the percentage of people who feel involved in decision making in the City.
