The Head of Planning and Housing Services then set out proposed amendments to the draft document in response to submissions from the consultation exercise.					
	The Portfolio Holder for Environment and Infrastracture drew Members attention to the lengthy consultation exercise which had been undertaken on this matter, and to the large number of comments which had been received. He congratulated Officers for the work which they had carried out in both the consultation exercise and the way in which those comments, including non planning related comments, had been dealt with.
