**1 THE APPLICATION
(Appendix A)**

1.1 Applicant

Cumbria Constabulary

In accordance with Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 an application has been received from Cumbria Constabulary, for the review of the premises licence relating to Crown Inn, 23 Scotland Road, Carlisle.

1.2 Grounds for review

The Police have stated that the grounds for the review are: Evidence of increased crime and disorder, the prevention of a public nuisance as well as concerns for the welfare of young children. They have provided additional information to amplify this

1.3 The application has been copied and forwarded to the Premises Licence Holder as well as all Responsible Authorities. Further additional details supporting the application have also been forwarded.

1.4 The application has been advertised on the premises, at the Council offices and the Council website as required by statute for a 28 day period.

1.5 No further representations have been made by other responsible authorities

1.6 Ford & Warren Solicitors represent Punch Taverns the Premises Licence holder. Gemma Louise Brown has recently taken over as designated premises supervisor and will also be in attendance.

1.7 The Licensing authority must, having regard to the application and any relevant representations, take such steps it considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives. These steps are:

- (a) to modify the conditions of the licence;
- (b) to exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the licence;
- (c) to remove the designated supervisor;
- (d) to suspend the licence for a period not exceeding 3 months;
- (e) to revoke the licence
- (f) Issue an informal warning to the Licence holder and/or to recommend improvement within a particular time

2 PREMISES LICENCE

Premises: Crown Inn, 23 Scotland Road, Carlisle. (**Area Plan & premises plan Appendix B**)

2.1 Holder of Premises Licence

Punch Taverns PLC of Jubilee House, Second Avenue, Burton Upon Trent are the Premises Licence holder. They have been the holders of the Premises licence since April 2007.

2.2 Current permitted hours

Sale by retail of alcohol On and Off the Premises.

- Monday - Wednesday 10am – Midnight.
 - Thursday - Sunday 10am- 1am.
 - Friday – Monday during statutory Bank Holiday Weekends 10am-2am.
 - Thursday when prior to Good Friday 10am-2am.
- Christmas Eve - Terminal hour extended by one hour.

2.3 Non Standard Timings: In respect of the four Saint's days- 1 March, St Patrick- 17th March, St George- 23 April, St Andrew- 30th November, or on occasions of local, national or international significance, or for other charitable purposes, terminal hour for any requested licensable activity may be extended by one hour, 7 days notice and with agreement of police.

2.4 Regulated Entertainment permitted hours: (Same as sale of alcohol above including):
performance of live music
playing of recorded music;
performance of dance;
entertainment of a similar description to that falling within a performance of live music, any playing of recorded music or a performance of dance;
entertainment facilities for dancing;

2.5 Late Night Refreshment:

Permitted hours same as sale of alcohol and regulated entertainment including Non Standard Timings but commencement time is 11pm.

2.6 Current Designated Premises Supervisor

Gemma Louise Brown
Personal Licence Number: PA941 (Issued by Carlisle City Council)
Miss Brown took over the duties of Designated Premises Supervisor on 27th April 2009

2.7 Premises licence conditions attached to The Crown Inn

Licensing Act 2003 Mandatory Conditions

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises the supply of alcohol

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence –
- (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
 - (c) The supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a
 - (d) person who holds a personal licence

Mandatory Conditions where Door Supervisors are provided

Where a premises licence includes a condition that one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity, they must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

Embedded conditions

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours. In this condition, permitted hours means those hours permitted by this licence
The above restrictions do not prohibit:

- (a) consumption of the alcohol on the premises or the taking of sale or supply of alcohol to any person residing in the licensed premises.
- (b) the ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;
- (c) the sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;
- (d) the sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military or air forces.
- (e) the taking of alcohol from the premises by a person residing there; or
- (f) the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to any private friends of a person residing there who are bona fide entertained by him at his own expense, or the consumption of alcohol by persons so supplied; or
- (g) the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to persons employed there for the purpose of the business carried on by the holder of the licence, or the consumption of liquor so supplied, if the liquor is supplied at the expense of their employer or of the person carrying on or in charge of the business on the premises

Off Sales

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours.
In this condition, permitted hours means those hours permitted by this licence.

The above restrictions do not prohibit:

- (a) during the first sixty minutes after the above hours, the taking of alcohol from the premises unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
- (b) the ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;
- (c) the sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purpose of the trade or club;
- (d) the sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military or air forces.

Alcohol shall not be sold in an open container or be consumed in the licensed premises

Public Entertainment

The standard Conditions for Places of Public Entertainment adopted by this Council in 2002 are applicable to this licence.

The accommodation limit of the premises, including public, staff and performers shall not exceed **150** persons.

Private Entertainment

The provision of regulated entertainment, that is, the provision of dancing, music or any other entertainment of the like kind, is prohibited (unless it is a licensable activity included in this licence) with the exception of pre booked private events limited to pre invited guests only.

Recorded Music

Provision may be made for the public entertainment in the premises by the reproduction of wireless (including television) broadcasts (or of programmes included in any programme service [within the meaning of the Broadcasting Act 1990] other than a sound or television broadcasting service), or of public entertainment by way of music and singing only which is provided solely by the reproduction of recorded sound.

2.8 Conditions Consistent with the Operating Schedule

General

We have applied for an extended period between the cessation of the supply of alcohol and the closure of the premises to give us the option to allow for a more gradual dispersal of customers. The style and operation of the pub will not differ significantly during the extended hours. Where this is appropriate, non-alcoholic refreshment will be available in the extended period.

The premises will respect Spirit Group's Approach to Responsible Drinking (a copy of which is enclosed in support of this application). Our policies change at regular intervals to reflect current trends and it would be inappropriate to standardise them on a permanent basis. The enclosed policy is included for information only and not as suggested conditions or to form part of any other Operating Schedule.

In respect of the four Saint's days, St David-1 March, St Patrick-17 March, St George- 23 April, St Andrew- 30 November, or on occasions of local, national or

international significance, or for other charitable purposes, terminal hour for any requested licensable activity may be extended by one hour, 7 days notice and agreement of police.

The Prevention of Crime and Disorder

When door staff are used they will be Security Industry Authority (SIA) approved and operate in accordance with the security industry guidelines.

A zero tolerance towards illegal drugs will be enforced at all times.

If a disc jockey is used on any night then he or she will ask customers to leave quietly.

If a CCTV system is installed at this site, it will continue to operate during the additional hours of trading and notices will be displayed.

All instances of crime and disorder will be reported to the police and will be kept in an incident log book..

Public Safety

Public safety is integral to the way that the Spirit Group runs its business and is reviewed regularly through our health and safety policy. This policy is fully briefed and trained to all management and staff and we will continue to train our staff to the standards required by relevant legislation. Free drinking water will be available at all times.

The Prevention of Public Nuisance

Additional patrols will take place by members of staff, internally and externally, to limit any noise pollution when entertainment is offered within the premises.

If appropriate, notices will be displayed asking our customers to respect our neighbours when leaving the premises.

Where already used text/radio pagers will continue to be used for the additional hours of trading and will be monitored by a responsible member of staff.

Soft drinks and non alcoholic refreshment will be available if we decide to use the option to stay open for an extended period between the cessation of the supply of alcohol and the closure of premises (see above under General).

The Protection of Children from Harm

When children are allowed on the premises, any entertainment offered within the premises will be suitable for young persons.

Children will be required to be supervised by the accompanying adult at all times.

A no smoking area will be provided.

Soft drinks and non alcoholic drinks will be available.

A recognised Proof of Age Policy will be enforced.

3 POLICY FRAMEWORK

- 3.1 It is a corporate objective to promote a healthy and safe Carlisle. The determination of an application to review a premises licence in accordance with the Act and its statement of licensing policy, fulfils that objective.
- 3.2 Paragraph 5.2.1 of the Carlisle City Council statement of licensing policy states 'The authority will view seriously applications for the review of any premises licence where it involves:
- Persistent failure to comply with licence conditions
 - Actions or omissions by the licensee (or his staff) which undermine the licensing objectives, particularly where they endanger public safety, expose children to harm or cause public nuisance'.
- 3.3 Paragraph 5.2.2 goes on to say that the authority will also view particularly seriously, any applications for review where the police have frequently been called to attend incidents of disorder at the premises and there have been frequent sales of alcohol to under age, or persons already intoxicated.
- 3.4 Guidance is offered to licensing authorities under Section 182 of the Act, by the Secretary of State in relation to the review of premises licences. In particular, the guidance refers to the options available to the authority (see 1.7 of this report), paragraph 11.18 of the guidance states ' In deciding which of these powers to invoke, it is expected that licensing authorities should so far as possible seek to establish the cause or causes of the concerns which the representations identify. The remedial action taken should generally be directed at these causes and should always be no more than a necessary and proportionate response. For example, licensing authorities should be alive to the possibility that the removal and replacement of the designated supervisor may be sufficient to remedy a problem where the cause of the identified problem directly relates to poor management decisions made by that individual. Equally, it may emerge that poor management is a direct reflection of poor company practice or policy and the mere removal of the designated premises supervisor may be an inadequate response to the problems presented. Indeed, where subsequent review hearings are generated by representations, it should be rare merely to remove a succession of designated premises supervisors as this would be a clear indication of deeper problems which impact upon the licensing objectives'.
- 3.5 Paragraph 11.21 of the guidance relates to modification of the premises licence stating 'Licensing authorities should also note that modifications of conditions and exclusions of licensable activities may be imposed either permanently or for a temporary period of up to three months. Accordingly temporary changes or suspension of the licence for up to three months may be imposed. This could impact on the business holding the licence financially and would only be expected to be pursued as a necessary means of promoting the licensing objectives. Accordingly, a licence could be suspended for a weekend as a means of deterring the holder from allowing the problems that gave rise to the review to happen again. However, it will always be important that any detrimental financial impact that may result from a licensing authority's decision is necessary and proportionate to the promotion of the licensing objectives

in the circumstances that gave rise to the application for a review'.

4 THE LEGAL POSITION

- 4.1 The licensing authority must determine the application in accordance with Section 52 of the Act, which outlines the circumstances whereby a hearing is required and the options available to the committee when determining the application.
- 4.2 An appeal may be made to the magistrates' court against the decision of the authority by the responsible authority, interested party or premises licence holder, within 21 days from the date of being notified.
- 4.3 Section 52(11) provides that a determination under this section does not have effect until the end of the period given for appealing against the decision, or if the decision is appealed against, until the appeal is disposed of.

6 RISK MANAGEMENT IMPLICATIONS

- 6.1 By determining the application in accordance with the relevant sections of the Act, the statement of licensing policy and guidance offered by the secretary of state, the licensing authority is ensuring that the all of the licensing objectives are considered fully.

7. REASON FOR DECISION/RECOMMENDATION

- 7.1 The Licensing Authority has received an application from the Cumbria Constabulary for the review of the premises licence relating to the premises The Crown Inn, 23 Scotland Road, Carlisle. They have stated that the grounds for the review are: Evidence of increased crime, disorder and public nuisance. Concerns for the safety of children.
- 7.2 The application will be determined in accordance with the relevant sections of the Act, the statement of licensing policy and guidance offered by the secretary of state

8. RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended the Committee determines the application in accordance with one of the options set out in paragraph 1.7 above.

An alarming increase in the number of incidents involving the premises has been highlighted over the past 2 years. A disproportionate level of Police attendance at the premises and evidence of increased crime and disorder.

Despite this increased level of incidents, several verbal warnings from Police and need for Police supervision, there has been no request for dialogue or proactive contact with the Police from the Licensee, other than a meeting called by the Police, with the DPS and Area Manager of Punch Taverns plc (premises licence holder), in November 2007, when an Action Plan was agreed, which has had no effect whatsoever on the disorder or noise and nuisance emanating from within and outside the public house.

Concern for residents' welfare and the prevention of public nuisance.

Police concern for the welfare of young children having to walk through broken glass and past half full glasses of alcohol regularly left on the pavement throughout the day.

The Crown Inn is a public house situated in a residential area on the corner of Etterby Street and Scotland Road, Carlisle.

Deleted:

DPS, Miss Allison Jane Boyd, took over the responsibility of The Crown Inn on the 20th April 2007. Miss Boyd is also DPS of the Cumberland Inn, Botchergate, Carlisle, both licensed premises are leased to Mr Ian Brown and his wife Julie Brown works in the Crown Inn.

Over the year preceding Miss Boyd becoming DPS there was only 1 call for Police Service, bar staff seeking assistance in ejecting a male from the premises. Since Miss Boyd became DPS in April 2007 there have been 28 calls for Police Service. All of these relate to anti-social behaviour, criminal activity or disorder. (Chronology of incidents attached). Distressed residents living within the vicinity of the Crown Inn have told Police that they continuously suffer from gangs of people, usually youths, standing outside on the pavement, at both the front and side entrances, drinking alcohol, smoking, urinating into the street, or against and into neighbouring properties, vomiting on the pavement (which is often left throughout the following day) and causing a lot of noise, including swearing and shouting, which can be heard through double glazed windows. They have also witnessed very violent disorder emanating from within the pub and spilling out onto the street. They have seen people collapsed, through the effects of alcohol, in the doorway of the pub. These residents also told us of the daily litter, including broken glass, cigarette ends, vomit, half full glasses of alcohol, all left on the pavements outside The Crown Inn, or left in nearby residents' gardens, these can be left for days and local people, including children, have to walk through this mess in order to go about their daily business. Residents in this vicinity now have to sleep in the rear of their properties in order to counter-act the noise coming from outside the pub late at night. Each resident has said what a huge negative impact the Crown Inn now has on their quality of life, and how it has only been like this for the past couple of years. These residents are also extremely afraid of repercussions if their names are made public. (Statements attached).

Due to increased calls for Police service between 06/05/07 – 28/09/07, during which time there were 10 calls recorded, including large scale disorder, assaults and arrests and after speaking to residents in the vicinity, a meeting was called, by the Police, with the DPS, Alison Boyd and the Regional Manager of Punch Taverns, Helen Jarvis. At this meeting it was agreed to draw up an Action Plan. Actions agreed were as follows:

No glasses are to be taken outside the front of the premises and patrons to be encouraged to use the beer garden for smoking.

That the DPS Alison Boyd is to be DPS at either the Crown Inn or the Cumberland Inn but not both premises.

That the premises should close before 12 midnight unless registered door supervisors are employed.

All staff to be trained in the use of the CCTV system and for any footage to be made available to police on request.

(Action Plan attached)

None of the agreed Actions were adhered to or reduced calls for Police service. Since this Action Plan was agreed, there have been a further 18 incidents recorded, relating to reports of serious and large scale disorder in the street, involving Mr Brown and his wife Julie Brown, another incident involved a male detained by Police with a knife and incidents of criminal damage and suspected drug activity.

On 23rd March 2009 independent Statements were taken from numerous residents living in the vicinity of The Crown Inn.

On Saturday 28th March 2009, a group were playing inside the Crown Inn, residents rang to say that up to a dozen customers were standing outside the pub drinking alcohol and smoking, these people were shouting and one male was urinating against a neighbouring property, another was seen to vomit into the street. Breaking glass could be heard. This behaviour went on until at least 1230 am. No registered door staff were employed for this event.

On Saturday 4th April 2009 a member of the Licensing Team observed the Crown Inn

at 9 pm and 11pm, on both these visits he witnessed gangs of up to 12 youths, ages between approx 18 – early 20's, standing outside the pub, smoking, drinking alcohol, swearing and shouting in a loud manner and climbing onto street furniture. He also witnessed one male vomiting up against the pub wall, which was still there at 11 pm on his second visit. He saw a large amount of broken glass and cigarette ends on the pavement. At no time did he see a member of staff address any of this behaviour or attempt to clear the broken glass or vomit.

On Sunday 5th April 2009 at 1300 hours, a Police Officer walking past the Crown Inn noted broken glass and cigarette ends on the pavement around the pub and also a pint pot was sat on the pavement, containing alcohol. (Photograph attached).

The everyday running and monitoring of the premises is totally inadequate and lack of supervision by Managers and staff have caused a negative impact on residents' lives and compromises customers' safety.

As a previous meeting with a representative of Punch Taverns and the DPS has proved unsuccessful and the ongoing reports of noise, nuisance and disorder continue, we have no other option that to request a Licence Review.



Action plan

1. Due to the smoking ban an increased number of customers are congregating outside the front of the premises to smoke. They are taking their drinks outside with them. This is a residential area and the noise from outside the public house is affecting the quality of life of the local residents causing several to comment that they have had to start sleeping in the rear of the house.

Recommendation

No glasses are to be taken outside the front of the premises and patrons to be encouraged to use the beer garden for smoking.

2. The current DPS is also the DPS at another very busy public house in the town centre which means that she is unable to spend enough time at the Crown to ensure that things run smoothly.

Recommendation

That the DPS Alison Boyd is to be DPS at either the Crown or the Cumberland but not both premises.

3. The Crown do not employ door staff even if they are holding functions. As a result of this there has been large scale disorder in the early hours of the morning.

Recommendation

That the premises should close before 12 midnight unless registered door supervisors are employed.

4. There have been several assaults at the premises where CCTV should have been available to the police but due to lack of staff training and lack of cooperation from the staff this evidence has been lost.

Recommendation

All staff to be trained in the use of the CCTV system and for any footage to be made available to police on request.

At the conclusion of the meeting Helen Jarvis stated that she would take my recommendations back to the owner of The Crown Ian Brown for information and attention.

After this statement nothing changed. I witnessed Ian Brown's partner/wife fighting in the street. I also witnessed another fight involving 2 youths who had come out of the pub & were fighting in the street, stopping the traffic. During this time, 2007, I put up with the noise & disorder as I thought it might just be teething problems & that it would all settle.

During 2008, in the summer months, I saw a group of males, with alcohol in pint pots, standing over the road from the pub, they were associated with vehicles racing up & down a rear lane of ETTABRY ST.

One evening at approx 11.30pm I saw Ian Brown's partner / wife doubled over, in the street, & another female rubbing her back, there were approx 6-8 males across the road, I heard her screaming at the top of her voice at them & then I watched as she ran over to this group, right into the centre of them & started punching & fighting, Ian Brown then came out of the pub & started fighting with another male, I then watched as some of the males then kicked Ian Brown to the ground & kick him in the body, I felt physically sick watching this violence, it was horrific, I felt so scared, I have never seen anything like this before. The next day I rang the Police & pleaded for something to be done about this pub & its clientele. I know that someone called "Dickie" who is banned from the City Centre bars drinks in the Crown. ..... I am the above named person & I reside at the address
overleaf. I have lived with my husband at this address for
over 20 years and for the last 10 years we have been
doing bed & breakfast. Directly opposite us is The Crown
public house and we obviously knew when we bought the
house that the pub was opposite and up until a couple
of years ago we used the pub on a regular basis particularly
at lunch times. When the previous licensee's were in the
pub we used to hear noise from the pub but it was just
people laughing and having a good time & the noise didn't
ever bother us.

Not long after this incident they started to play really loud music some nights until 4-00 am. I phoned the police to report this because it was ridiculously loud & you could hear it from Stearns Bank.

The main problem I have with the pub is the amount of people standing outside drinking and smoking and I find it quite uncomfortable walking past them. I will go to the Spar in the afternoon but will not go past them in the evening because I do not feel safe. I can't understand why they are standing out there drinking. I have noticed that there has been silt all over the street and there are cigarette ends everywhere. We have found glasses in the lane and the whole atmosphere in the street has changed since the pub changed hands. Some weekends it is quiet but other weekends when they have do's the noise is terrible. We do B & B and it is very difficult for our guests who sleep in the front of the house to get any sleep. This noise regularly goes on until the early hours of the morning.

The Crown is in the middle of a nice residential area and up until 2 years ago it was part of the community and the owners respected its neighbours but

I live in the vicinity of the Crown Inn, Stanwix. I have already made a statement to the police about the noise, disorder and anti social behaviour coming from the Crown Inn. Since my last statement on 23rd March 2009 the disorder and anti social behaviour has continued.

On Saturday 28th March 2009 I was aware that due to a televised football match which continued into a live game playing the pub was very busy.

○ At approx. between 8pm and 8:30pm I saw 10-12 males and females gathered at side entrance to the Crown stood in the street, smoking and holding glasses of alcohol. I know this as I had to go to the window to see what the noise was. There was a lot of shouting. I also saw a male in his early 20's urinating against the funeral parlour door.

② I was very upset as this is very distressing to watch, it did occur to me here we go again. This behaviour from the Crown is now continuous.

All throughout the evening there was a group of approx. 6-12 youths at any one time outside the pub smoking and drinking. This noise continued all evening. During the evening there was also people vomiting outside which was all over Eborby Street.

A car arrived (Ford Focus) pulled up near the side entrance at the Crown. The passenger went into the pub via side entrance. Meanwhile the driver got out of the car and urinated in full view of everyone. The passenger returned and they drove off.

At 22:45 at the end of my tether I rang for the police following the sound of broken glass. At this time there were 10-12 male and females gathered at the side entrance.

This upsetting, distressing behaviour continued until at least 12:30 am preventing me from sleeping causing me immense distress. 36

I desperately need somebody to address these problems as our quality of life is affected and we feel like we are living on a knife edge waiting for the next incident.

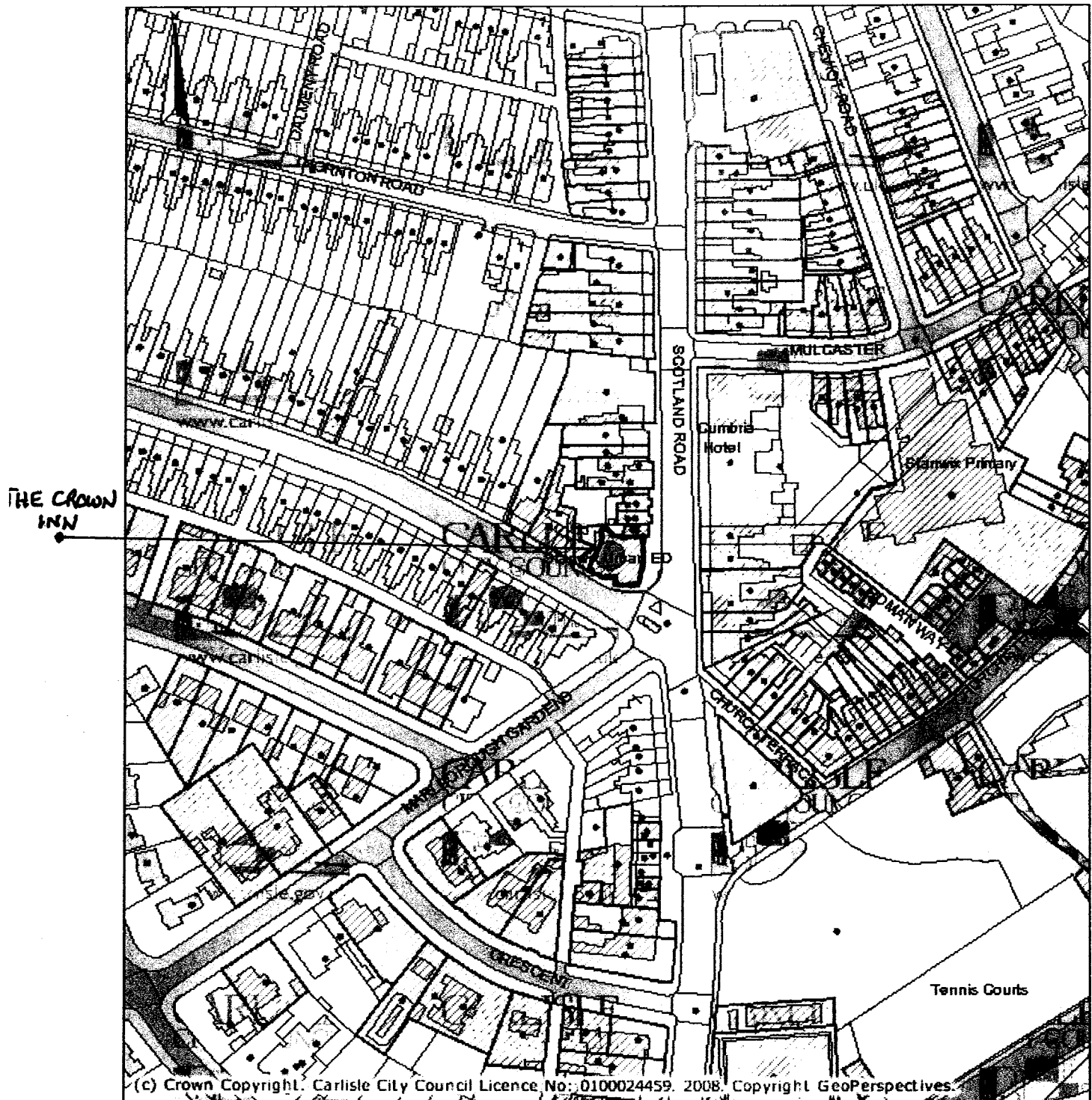

At approximately 11pm I returned to the The Crown Inn. There was a group of about 9 or 10 youths, male and female, drinking outside the front doors of the premises. 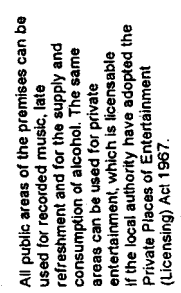
