An online and paper based public consultation was held between 16/05/2022 and 03/06/2022 to determine the views of residents as to their preferred types of play equipment and surfacing for the site, resulting in 89 responses, all of which were online.  The Healthy City Team used the data collected from the consultation to draw together a specification for new play equipment and surfacing which best meets the needs of the community. This was tendered via an existing framework agreement during June 2022.  Four tenders were received for the project, with the highest scoring being Playdale Playgrounds Ltd.  The following costs are now allocated to this project:  £64,956.69 Playdale Playgrounds Ltd – supply and installation of equipment and surfacing.  £6283.51 Steelway Fensecure Ltd – supply of perimeter fencing.  £2312.00 Block Fencing Contractors Ltd – installation of perimeter fencing.
