**Subject Matter**

The Assistant Director (Economic Development) submitted report ED.09/10 concerning the draft Energy Efficiency Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) which had been written to support the objectives of Planning Policy Statement 1 Supplement 'Planning for Climate Change' and to expand on the Council's planning policies.

The matter had been considered and was well received by the Environment and Economy Overview and Scrutiny Panel on 24 June 2010, who had resolved:

- "1)     That consultation should be extended to include all Members; and
- 2)     That anaerobic digestion be included in the document."

A copy of Minute Extract EEOSP.46/10 had been circulated.

The Assistant Director (Economic Development) recommended that the Executive refer the draft Supplementary Planning Document, subject to integration of the issue of anaerobic digestion, to Council for approval to consult on the content of the draft SPD.

In moving the recommendations, the Economic Development Portfolio Holder thanked the Environment and Economy Overview and Scrutiny Panel for the very good debate undertaken on the issue. She further commended the Assistant Director for submission of what was a very clear document, commenting that everyone should contribute to the promotion of energy efficiency.
