LC.14/13 UPDATE ON LICENSING ACT 2003

The Licensing Officer presented report GD.31/13 giving Members an update on the applications under the Licensing Act 2003.

The Licensing Officer reported on the licence figures as 17 May 2013. He reported that all fees under the Licensing Act were fixed by Central Government and would be reviewed to ensure that Licensing Authorities recovered the full cost of administrating the licensing function.

He added that the Government were considering reducing the burden on premises who wished to carry out Regulated Entertainment. This could include an increase in the minimum number of participants to 500 before the activity was required to be licensed. Further information would be reported to the Committee as it became available.
