1. References from the Executive

There are no references from the Executive.

2. Forward Plan Items

The Forward Plan of the Executive covering the period 1 December 2009 - 31 March 2010 was published on 17th November 2009.

Appendix 2 contains the Forward Plan items which fall within the remit of this Panel. There are no items on the current plan which the Panel needs to take a decision about whether to scrutinise or not.

Further issues relating to the Forward Plan which Members may wish to discuss:

- KD.036/09 Carbon Management Plan The matter was scheduled to be considered by Executive on 26 October 2009 but it was removed and a progress report will, however, be submitted to the Executive on 14 December 2009 (as a non-key decision).
- ii) **KD.040/09 Development Agreement for Morton Masterplan**. The matter has been deferred pending discussions with Cumbria County Council, and will be considered by the Executive as a non key decision early 2010.

3. Work Programme of the Panel

The most recent work programme for this Panel is attached at Appendix 1.

Further investigation was undertaken by the Chair on the following issues.

- i) **Rickergate** the development brief is currently out to tender and a report for Panel will not be available until February/March 2010 at the earliest,
- Lifelong Homes the Panel will receive a report at their next meeting on 21st January 2010 which contains some information on Lifelong Homes. The Panel can then decide if there is scope for further work and how we wish to proceed.

4. Movement Strategy

The Chair of the Panel has written to the Acting Chief Executive of Cumbria County Council expressing the Panels concerns over the delay of the above document and requesting further information on the reasons for the delay and when the document would be available for this panel to scrutinise. At the time of writing this report no response has been received from the County Council.

5. Scrutiny Chairs Group

The Scrutiny Chairs Group met on Wednesday 28th October. The minutes from this meeting have already been circulated to scrutiny Members. In relation to the meeting, the Chairs group asked that the three Overview and Scrutiny Panels be asked to consider if they agree that:

- All Scrutiny Chairmen and Vice-Chairmen are shared across all political parties;
- The Chairmen and Vice-Chairmen remain in role for two consecutive years to allow for continuity in Scrutiny and Task and Finish Group work;
- The Chairmanship of each Overview and Scrutiny Panel is rotated between the three political groups every two years;
- The current Chairman and Vice-chairman of each Overview and Scrutiny Panel remain in place for the next municipal year;
- If the above recommendations are agreed, would the Panels want the Constitution amended or would the Panels want the Council to agree the amendments without changing the Constitution?
- That the legal view is sought on how the Chairs Group can move forward on their recommendations above;
- That each political group carry out a skills audit of their Members to ensure the appropriate Members are involved in work they are skilled or interested in

Of course, the discussion the Chairs Group had was without knowledge of the proposals to reduce the number of Scrutiny Panels from 3 to 2 (also on today's agenda). Members may wish to consider how the proposals above on Chairs would be applied to a system with just 2 scrutiny panels, rather than 3.

The Chairs Group also recommended that we sought legal advice on the best way to proceed with these changes if scrutiny Members were so minded. The advice received suggests that any agreement about the Chairs could be made either:

- through an amendment to the O&S Procedure Rules of the Constitution or;
- through a Protocol agreed by the O&S Panels and signed up to by all three political groups. This approach would require a degree of engagement between the Chairs Group and the Leaders of the political groups in developing such a protocol;

The advice went on to suggest that a Protocol was considered a more attractive way of handling the proposals as it retained flexibility and would more easily allow room for changes in the future.

In addition to these questions, the Terms of Reference of the Chairs Group were amended slightly – these now appear in Appendix 3.

Appendix 3: Amended Terms of Reference for Scrutiny Chairs Group

The Chairs Group will comprise of the three Chairs and the three Vice-chairs of the Scrutiny Panels. No substitute system will operate for the group. The purpose of the Scrutiny Chairs Group is:

"To deal with any overarching scrutiny issues and help provide strategic direction to scrutiny development matters."

Minutes will be taken by a clerk from Legal and Democratic services at all meetings of the Scrutiny Chairs Group. Once agreed, these minutes will be circulated by email to all Scrutiny Members and the Group Leaders.

Any Member of the Scrutiny Chairs Group can call a meeting of the group – they will do this by asking a member of the Scrutiny Team to organise a meeting at the earliest opportunity. Equally, where the Scrutiny Team consider that there is business for the Chairs Group, they will contact the Members to suggest that a meeting be held.

The Chairs Group is not a formal body of the Council and has no formal powers. Any referrals to Council will need to come from the officers of the Scrutiny Team but with the minute extract from the group to make clear that the recommendation had been 'approved' by the group. When an item is being referred to Council, the Scrutiny Chairs Group will decide at its meeting which Member will speak to the item at the relevant Council meeting.
