Neat streets...

- 'Pilot' clean up initiative for Carlisle
- Targeting un-adopted back lanes, to
 - engage with residents
 - improve the local environment
 - 're-claim' community spaces.
- To tackle:
 - Fly tipping
 - Litter
 - Dog fouling
 - Landlords and tenants

Action...

Stage 1:

- Letter drop: residents asked to support the initiative by:
 - keeping the lanes clear of dumped items etc
 - reporting information to support enforcement action against those who:
 - fly tip / litter / allow their dogs to foul etc

Stage 2:

- Extensive clean up with the Council working alongside residents

Stage 3:

- Regular monitoring and follow up enforcement action

Stage 4:

- Review and roll out of pilot
- Identification of other streets

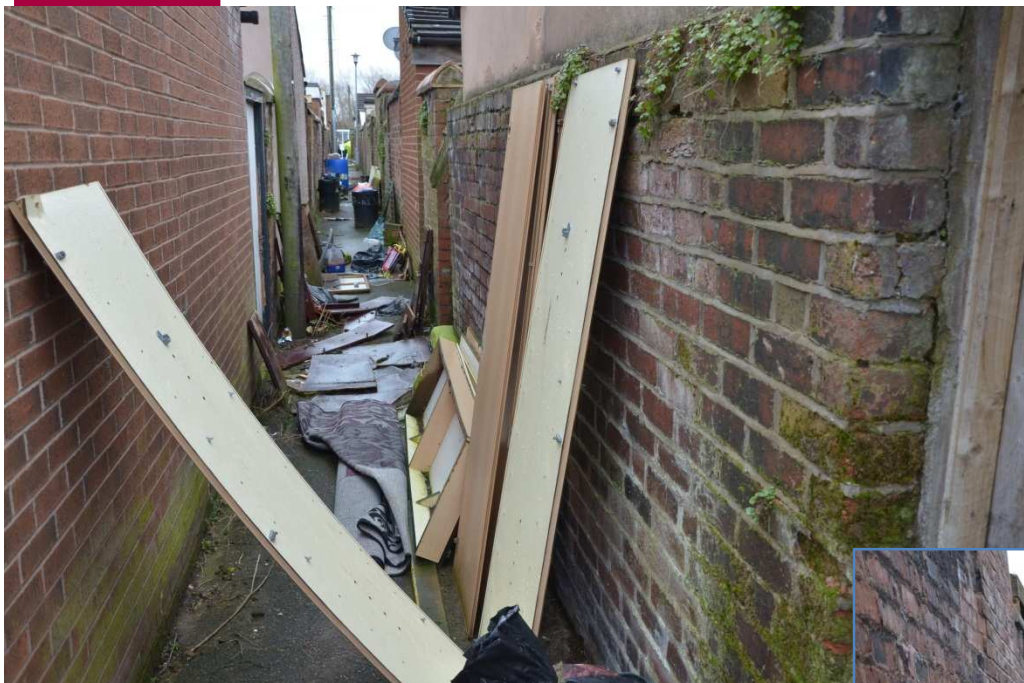

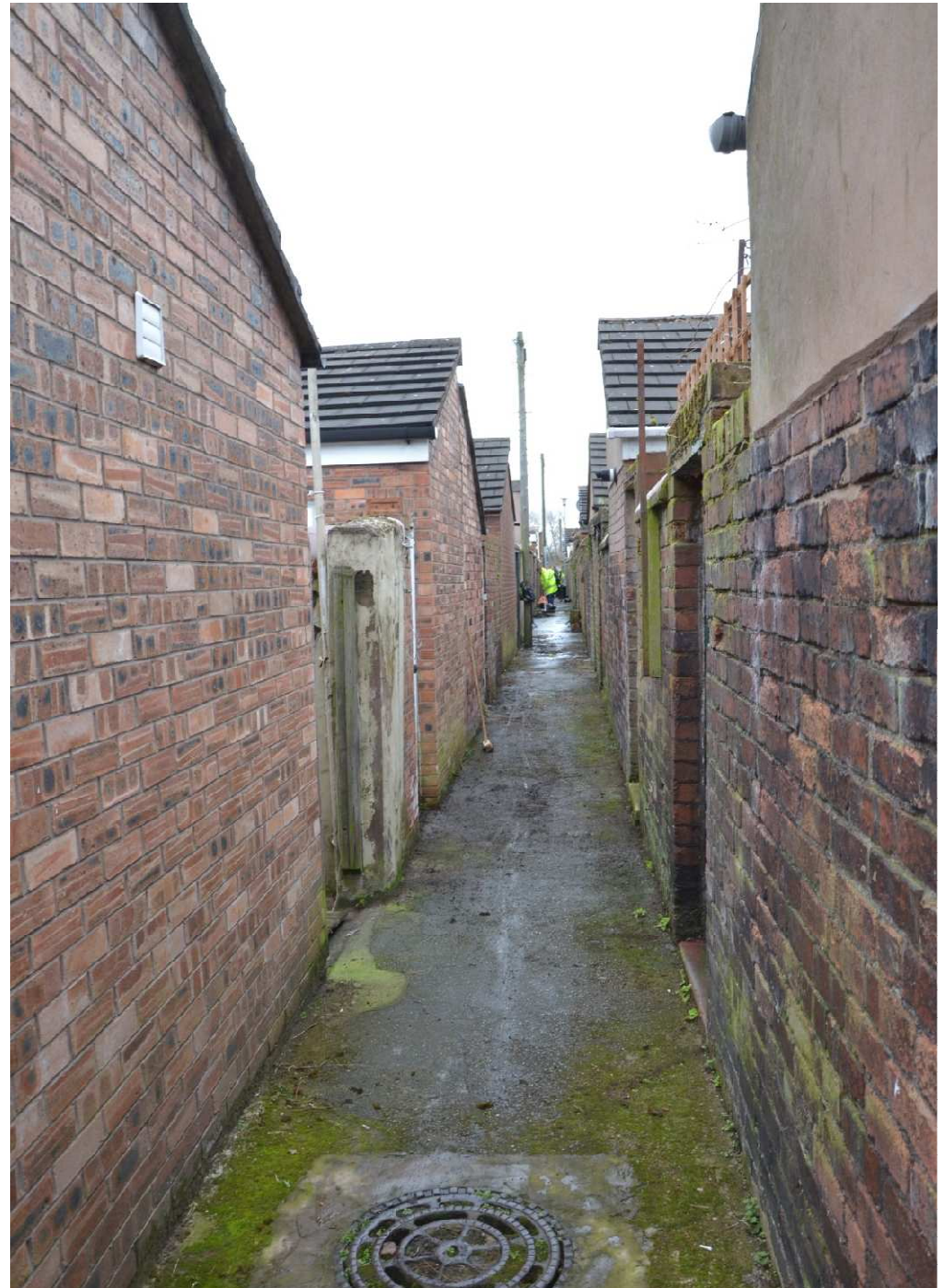
