# EXCERPT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE EXECUTIVE HELD ON 17 DECEMBER 2012

#### EX.161/12 REVIEW OF CHARGES 2013/14

(Key Decision – KD.033/12)

Portfolio Cross-cutting

**Relevant Overview and Scrutiny Panel** Community; Environment and Economy; and Resources

#### **Subject Matter**

Pursuant to Minutes EX.133/12, EX.134/12, EX.135/12 and EX.136/12, further consideration was given to the Charges Reviews in respect of charges falling within the responsibility of the Local Environment; Community Engagement; Economic Development; and Governance and Resources Directorates. Copies of reports LE.34/12, CD.53/12, ED.35/12 and GD.64/12 had been circulated. In addition, the Director of Local Environment had prepared a paper which reflected the amendments to the charging proposals for Talkin Tarn car park and corrected an error in the proposal to introduce a new charge for lost and replacement containers at paragraph 6.4 (LE.34/12), copies of which had been circulated to all Members on 23 November 2012. The Director of Community Engagement had also produced an Addendum to the Community Engagement Charges Report (CD.53/12) setting out amended charges for Hostels and Home shares, which had been circulated to all Members on 7 December 2012.

Copy Extracts from the Minutes of the meetings of the Community Overview and Scrutiny Panel on 22 November 2012 (COSP.80/12); Environment and Economy Overview and Scrutiny Panel on 29 November 2012 (EEOSP.74/12); and Resources Overview and Scrutiny Panel on 4 December 2012 (ROSP.89/12) in respect of the charges were also submitted.

The Finance, Governance and Resources Portfolio Holder moved the following recommendations, which were seconded by the Leader:

- the recommendations contained in report LE.3412 in respect of the Local Environment
  Directorate, subject to the amended charges for Talkin Tarn car park and correction of
  the error at paragraph 6.4 of the report, as detailed in the paper prepared by the Director
  of Local Environment.
- the recommendations contained within report CD.53/12 (Community Engagement Directorate), subject to the amended charges for Hostels and Home shares as set out in the Addendum to the report.

- the recommendations contained within report ED.35/12 in respect of the Economic Development Directorate.
- the recommendations contained within report GD.64/12 with regard to the Governance and Resources Directorate.

The Leader further indicated that the Executive had taken on board feedback from the Overview and Scrutiny Panel meetings in formulating its budget proposals, but he was happy to invite Panel Chairmen to speak should they have any further comments to add. In response, the Chairman of the Community Overview and Scrutiny Panel stated that she had nothing further to add.

The Chairman of the Environment and Economy Overview and Scrutiny Panel had no further comments, other than to welcome the setting up of a Task and Finish Group to explore in detail issues relating to Talkin Tarn.

The Chairman of the Resources Overview and Scrutiny Panel reported that the Panel had reached a consensus on the budget. Members had concerns regarding the availability of resources, but considered that the draft budget was quite reasonable.

**Summary of options rejected** a number of alternative charges as detailed in the above reports

#### **DECISION**

- 1. That the fees and charges for 2013/14 relating to those services falling within the responsibility of the Local Environment Directorate (set out in Report LE.34/12 and relevant Appendices) be approved with effect from 1 April 2013, subject to:
  - the amended charges for Talkin Tarn car park; and correction of an error in the proposal to introduce a new charge for lost and replacement containers at paragraph 6.4 (LE.34/12), as set out in the paper prepared by the Director of Local Environment.
- 2. That the fees and charges, as set out in Report CD.53/12 and the Addendum thereto, be approved with effect from 1 January 2013 in respect of the Hostel Services and Disabled Facilities Grants falling within the responsibility of the Community Engagement Directorate.
- 3. That the fees and charges, as set out in the relevant Appendices to Report ED.35/12, be approved with effect from 1 April 2013 for areas falling within the responsibility of the Economic Development Directorate.

- 4. That the fees and charges, as set out in Appendix A to Report GD.64/12, be approved with effect from 1 April 2013 in respect of the service areas and functions falling within the Governance and Resources Directorate.
- 5. That the Executive noted the Licensing Charges which had been approved by the Regulatory Panel on 21 November 2012.
- 6. That the Overview and Scrutiny Panels be thanked for their consideration of and contribution to the matter.

#### **Reasons for Decision**

The proposed charges and options reflected the Corporate Charging Policy as set out in the Medium Term Financial Plan, whilst attempting to recognise service pressures and trends.

# EXCERPT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE EXECUTIVE HELD ON 17 DECEMBER 2012

#### EX.172/12 CARLISLE TOURIST INFORMATION CENTRE

(Non Key Decision)

**Portfolio** Culture, Health, Leisure and Young People

Relevant Overview and Scrutiny Panel Environment and Economy

#### **Subject Matter**

Pursuant to Minute EEOSP.73/12, consideration was given to a reference from the Environment and Economy Overview and Scrutiny Panel regarding the final report of the Carlisle Tourist Information Centre Task and Finish Group. The Panel had resolved:

"2) That the Carlisle Tourist Information Centre Task and Finish Group report be approved and presented to the Executive with a request for a formal response."

Copies of Report OS.36/12 and the Minute Excerpt had been circulated.

The Lead Member of the Task and Finish Group was present at the meeting. He thanked the Officers involved in helping the Task and Finish Group draw up the report, which would run in tandem with the capital project at the Tourist Information Centre for next year.

The Lead Member further expressed the hope that the work undertaken would improve the Tourist Information Centre and that the Executive would support the recommendations, namely:

- "1. Immediate action should be taken to:
- replacing the aging cash register in the TIC enabling better monitoring of retail stock.
- lowering of part of the counter within the TIC to accommodate the needs of disabled visitors
- provide new and improved signage outside the TIC
- 2. All means of modern technology should continue to be assessed to enable easy access to information and enhance the experience of visitors to both the TIC and the wider Carlisle city centre area.
- 3. Appropriate support be given to Officers in their task of sourcing a higher quality of

merchandising available within the TIC especially focusing on local supplier arrangements such as Made in Cumbria.

- 4. Consideration be given to an alternative accommodation booking system in the light of the high cost of the Destination Management System(DMS) as currently operated by the TIC.
- 5. That an Options Paper be drawn up to examine the alternative ways forward for use of the Assembly Rooms within the Town hall and the use of the office area at the western end of the Old Town hall at second floor level.
- 6. That following the completion of this Report by this Task Group, a Working Group continues to sit within the Overview and Scrutiny framework to monitor the ongoing project development work to improve the Tourist Information Centre.

Initially during 2013 this Working Group should meet quarterly and report to the Economy & Environment Overview and Scrutiny Panel accordingly. In tandem with this a Project Development Plan be developed setting out short, medium and longer term improvement plans for the TIC facility as a gateway to the wider heritage of Carlisle as a whole."

In response, the Culture, Health, Leisure and Young People Portfolio Holder thanked Members of the Task and Finish Group for all their hard work. She had considered all of the recommendations and agreed that support was needed, together with a continuing relationship with the Task and Finish Group going forward.

The Culture, Health, Leisure and Young People Portfolio Holder added that the Executive would consider the matter and respond to each of the recommendations at the next Panel meeting on 17 January 2013.
