But ethos has not changed, bureaucracy has not changed, centralisation has not changed.

And the threat is still there, & Dr Kitchin was so fed up with this govts attitude he has emigrated to Canada.

My future.

We are talking about this; we are going through consultation and ministers are making speeches but there does not seem to be any end game in sight. Is that a worry?
