- 1.1 The Licensing Act 2003 took effect on 24th November 2005, from which date this Council administered all licences issued.

3 Current Issues

3.1 Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011

This Act received Royal Assent last year and we are waiting for commencement dates which are expected to be 1 April and 1 October 2012. Areas covered by this new legislation include:

- Primary Care Trust to be a Responsible Authority
- The test in relation to licensing objectives would change from 'necessary to appropriate'
- Changes to Temporary Event Notices
- Suspend licence upon non-payment of annual fee
- Review of Statements of Licensing Policy extended to every 5 years
- Early Morning Restriction Orders on closing hours
