NOTICE is hereby given in accordance with Rule 15 (General Exception) of the Access to Information Procedure Rules; and Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 of a Key Decision in respect of matters which were not in the Notice of Executive Key Decisions for decision on 22 November 2021, and which the Leader has indicated will now be considered at a meeting of the Executive on that date.

The item relates to the Local Government Reorganisation – Implementation Reserve.

The report summarises the resources required to fund the implementation costs of Local Government Reorganisation (LGR) within Cumbria, and requests appropriate delegations to the Council's S151 Officer to identify a funding source from earmarked reserves held by the Council in order to contribute up to £1.6million to a County wide Implementation Reserve. Each authority is taking a report to their Executive and due to the tight timescales it had not been possible to include the matter in the Notice of Executive Key Decisions.

The Leader has agreed that the above matter should be considered at the meeting of the Executive on 22 November 2021, in accordance with the above Procedure Rules and Regulations; and to comply with the Council's governance arrangements, as he considers that the decisions should be taken by that date and it is impractical to defer the decisions.
