HB caseload is reducing, as housing costs support for new Working Age claims, is paid through Universal Credit.

CTRS rose initially and then since the Furlough scheme was extended, has been falling very slowly too. There is an expectation that the various High Street store closures and planned changes to the current furlough scheme may impact in late Qtr. 4 or early Qtr. 1 of 2021/22, but it is difficult to predict what will happen.
