2 Local Plan.

To inquire into the roll-forward of the Carlisle and District Local Plan, with particular reference to a series of discussion papers to be brought forward by Officers on subjects such as provision for housing, retail, employment etc.

The Executive suggests this work might be allocated to the Infrastructure Overview and Scrutiny Committee.

3 Cemeteries and Crematorium: Income and Expenditure.

To inquire into the current levels of income and expenditure generated by the cemeteries and crematorium service, and explore options for closing the current annual deficit between income and expenditure.

The Executive suggests this work might be allocated to the Corporate Resources Overview and Scrutiny Committee.
