**TULLIE HOUSE DEVELOPMENT PLAN**

The Director of Community Services submitted Report CS.18/07 providing an update on the current position regarding the Tullie House Development Plan. The Director advised that an application had been made to the Heritage Lottery Fund to develop the next stage of the Tullie House Development Plan. It was not anticipated that notification of the outcome of the application would be received until April 2007. If the application was approved, this would take the project forward to the next stage. Inevitably there would be a range of conditions associated with acceptance of the grant and the Council would become increasingly committed to contributing significant financial resources to the project. Clearly these commitments would compete against a range of other Council priorities.

The Director reminded Members that when future management options for Tullie House were last considered several years ago, the status quo was maintained. It was agreed that this be reviewed after 2 years and the timescale could be opportune to revisit the options.
