

CUMBRIA LEADERSHIP FORUM - DRAFT TERMS OF REFERENCE

PURPOSE

INFLUENCE

1. Provide leadership to promote the interests of Cumbria regionally, nationally and internationally.
2. Operate effectively within the regional context of NW England, and secure Cumbria's effective engagement in regional structures and arrangements.
3. Provide a means for the formulation and expression of joint views on issues of strategic significance, to the LGA, central government, and other bodies in respect of legislation, proposed legislation, policy and resource allocation.

VISION FOR CUMBRIA

4. Provide leadership in the development of shared outcomes for Cumbria; review priorities in light of performance information, and endorse the Single Community Strategy for Cumbria.
5. Provide strategic input into and endorse key strategies and plans which support the joint delivery of priority outcomes in the Single Community Strategy and which are critical to Cumbria's future success.

INNOVATION AND JOINT DELIVERY

6. Drive innovation in addressing key issues for the county.
7. Provide a means of co-ordination in respect of joint action and joint working, and ensure that opportunities for collaboration on service delivery and efficiency are given sufficient focus and drive.
8. Commission activity from the Chief Executive's Group in support of the CLF's agenda and priorities.

PARTNERSHIP AND ENGAGEMENT

9. Consult and liaise through the Cumbria Strategic Partnership Forum, with other organisations across the public, private and third sectors on issues of common interest.

10. Provide leadership to achieve change across Cumbria, facilitating improved partnership working across all sectors to improve outcomes, and maximise efficiencies.

LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT

11. Identify opportunities and increase collective capacity for shared learning and development across all partner organisations.

4. Provides an annual report on its achievements to the Cumbria Strategic Partnership Forum.
